UNIVERSITY NORTH CALLS

- calls for student mobility for study stays at
foreign institutions and internships at foreign
institutions in program and partner countries.
- call for student mobility for participating in
Blended Intensive Programs (BIP)
in program countries.
- call for staff mobility for teaching and training
purposes.



STAFF MOBILITY

Teaching staff can participate
in mobility for:

- Teaching assignments
(minimum of 8 hours of teaching
per week)
- Training
- Combination of teaching and
training
(minimum of 4 hours
of teaching per week)

Administrative staff can participate exclusively
in training activities.

Financial support:

- Daily allowance
(including 2 travel days) + travel costs

Training activities may include:

- Job shadowing – observing colleagues
at a foreign institution while they
carry out their professional activities
- Workshops or training courses

The main criterion for the selection of teaching
and administrative staff is the quality of the
teaching or work plan.



STUDENT MOBILITY

Erasmus+ opportunities for University North students

Erasmus+ offers students the possibility of:

- study stays
- internships
- combined study and internship mobility
- blended physical and virtual mobility
- short-term doctoral mobility
- participation in Blended Intensive Programs (BIP) at foreign institutions

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR LONG-TERM STUDENT MOBILITY:

€500–550 per month
(depending on the country)

- + €250 per month for students with fewer opportunities or lower socioeconomic status
- + €150 per month for internships
- + travel/green travel allowance

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SHORT-TERM STUDENT MOBILITY:

€79 per day for mobility lasting 5–14 days

€56 per day for mobility lasting 15–30 days

- + €100 for students with fewer opportunities for mobility lasting 5–14 days
- + €150 for students with fewer opportunities for mobility lasting 15–30 days
- + travel/green travel allowance

DURATION OF STUDENT MOBILITY

- Study stay: 3 to 12 months
- Internship: 2 to 12 months
- Combined blended mobility or BIP: 5–30 days of physical mobility + mandatory virtual mobility
- Short-term doctoral mobility: 5–30 days

Internships can also be undertaken within 12 months after graduation.
